

**E**  **Bostock v. Clayton County**. In that case, the Court held that discrimination based on sex in employment includes gender identity and sexual orientation. In its reasoning, the Order explains, other laws that prohibit discrimination based on sex discrimination;

- Ascertain whether their agencies' policies are consistent with the Order's stated policies.
- Consider whether to revise, suspend or rescind agency actions and procedures to implement the Order's stated policies.

- Within 100 days of the Order, work with the Attorney General to implement an action plan to carry out the actions identified in its review of its policies, programs, guidance, rules, or regulations and that may be inconsistent with the Order's stated policy.
